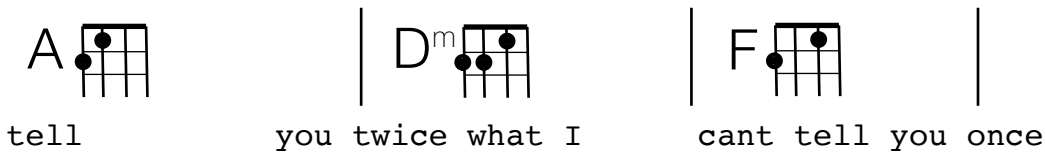
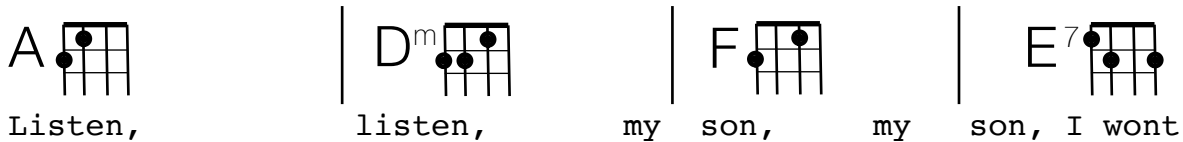


Verse= riff 1 & 2

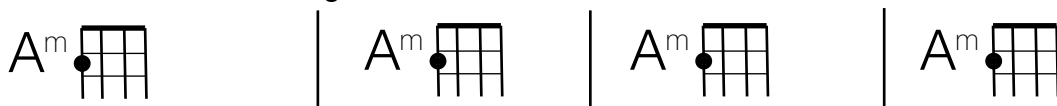


Put one foot in front of the other Is all I know. Be-

Instrumental: all 3 riffs together

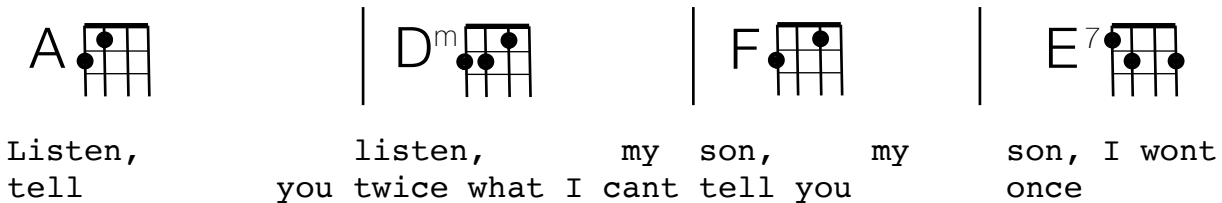
