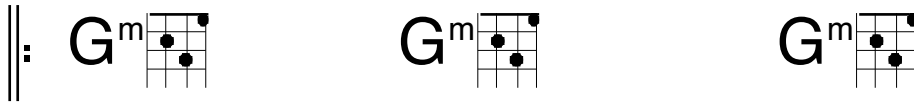


# Pipeline - by The Ventures. For uke with low bass G string

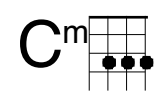

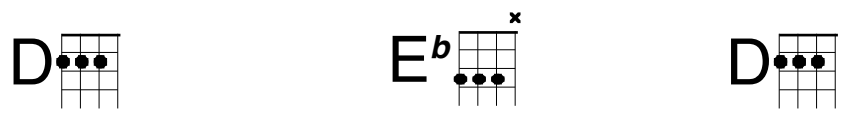
